

Jersey European Agility Festival - Dog Of The Year Finals



Rules – 2017



There will be four finals split into:

- 1st Final - Large Grade A
- 2nd Final - Large Grade B
- 3rd Final - Medium
- 4th Final - Small

A dog must have competed in all 4 qualifying classes to be considered for the finals. Qualifying classes are:

- Small: 17, 30, 35, 48
- Medium: 18, 31, 36, 49
- Large Grade A: 19, 32, 37, 50
- Large Grade B: 20, 33, 38, 51

All scores count towards qualifying for the finals, which will take place on Monday 1st May 2017 in the afternoon and will consist of an agility round.

The following dogs from each section with the highest points will be invited to take part in the finals:

	<u>Small</u>	<u>Medium</u>	<u>Large A</u>	<u>Large B</u>

If any dog is unable to compete in the finals the next dog on the points table will be invited to take part.

In the event of there being two dogs on the same points, the highest placed dog in the Agility round of Class 17/18/19/20 will qualify for the finals, if not the highest placed dog in the Agility round of Class 35/36/37/38 will qualify for the finals.
